

# Fitting Instructions

Position Stove where you want it.



Using Bradawl or other sharp implement put holes through the clamping rings, silicone seal and canvas to inside.



Secure inside clamping ring with washer and nut.



Secure all remaining washers and nuts.



Once the hole has been cut in the canvas put the flue through the silicone collar – make sure it is central.



Attach the outer flues.

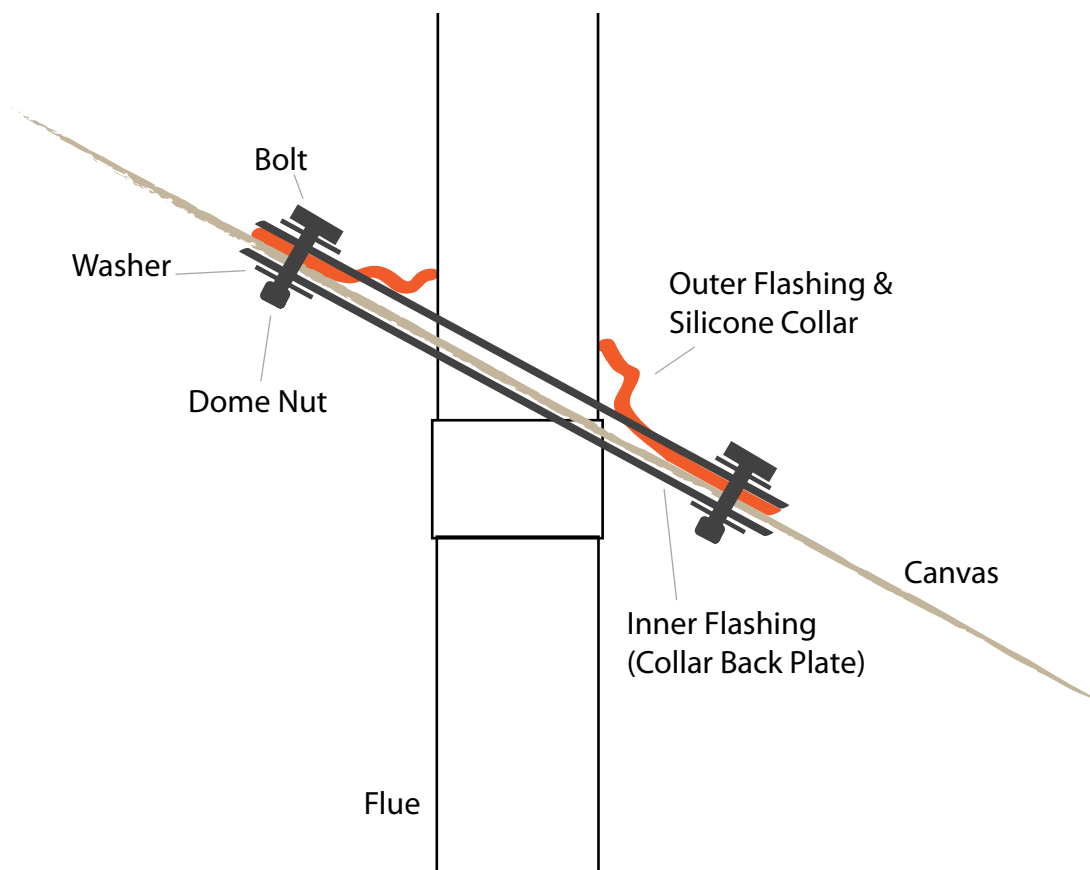


You are now ready to light your Frontier.

## Instructions

- The Frontier Flashing Kit is easily retrofitted to any canvas tent, tipi or shelter.
- This is easier to fit with two people but can be done with one.
- Position your stove where you want it to be in your shelter. We advise positioning the Frontier Stove away from the entrance door. It is important to keep the entrance clear as this tends to be a 'busy' area.
- Line the flue up with the inner ring.
- Position outer flashing on the outside of the tent.
- Poke a Bradawl or something similar through the holes in the outer clamping ring, the silicone sealing collar and through the canvas for the first bolt fitment to go in.

- Put the first bolt in place and attach to inside clamping ring. Put a washer on both sides of the clamping rings.
- Once the two clamping rings on each side of the tent are secure you can then attach the remaining bolts.
- With the clamping rings in place you are now ready to cut the hole in the canvas for the flue to go through (using a Stanley knife or scissors).
- Position the stove so the flue runs straight through the centre of the clamping rings.
- Erect the outer flues and your Frontier Stove is now ready to light.
- Always make sure the Frontier Stove is positioned on a carpet or fire retardant blanket as any accidental sparks may go straight through the groundsheet.
- Please note that if your Frontier has the flue damper closed for a prolonged period of time you will expect to see a build up of soot or tar in the lower flue section. This will disperse once the damper is opened and cooking temperatures are achieved.
- If lighting the Frontier Stove for the first time, make sure your shelter is well vented as first time burning of the Frontier will give off an odour of burning manufacturers residue. This disappears very quickly with increased heat.
